Lellbach Builders Finishes Charity Auction Remodel

Issues of housing are at the forefront of most discussions for DuPage PADS (Public Action to Deliver Shelter), Board of Directors member Doug Lellbach, who, with his wife Debra, owns Lellbach Builders. So it was natural that when collecting items to put up for auction at the PADS' Taste of Hope event Lellbach Builders would donate a remodeling project.

Naperville residents David and Jeanne Buddingh bid on and won the "Distinctive Powder Room Renovation" at the recent PADS' event. The remodel package included all the materials labor and accessories needed for a fresh look

It's great to think that this remodeling project not only improved our house but that since the services and products were all donated, all that we spent is going to help someone else's housing situation through PADS," said Jeanne Buddingh.

"I just think about how much remodeling one room changed our house, and the impact that housing can really have," Buddingh said. "I'm so glad that we won the auction."

DuPage PADS is committed to end and prevent homelessness in DuPage County; PADS is recognized in DuPage County for providing temporary, transitional and permanent supportive housing for people without homes.

"At the end of the day, I spend a lot of time working on changing people's housing situations, through Lellbach Builders and PADS, so to bring the two together was a natural collaboration for me," Doug Lellbach said. "I'm glad that not only did the Buddingh's powder room turn out so well, but that with the donations and help from all these other local businesses, the cost of the remodel was all given to PADS."

Lellbach Builders is coordinating another powder room renovation for another worthy cause – NCO Youth & Family Services' Denim and Diamond Auction slated for July 22nd.
